- ٧- أن صيام رمضان سبب لتكفير الذنوب التي سبقتها من رمضان الذي قبله إذا اجتنبت الكبائر.
- ٨- أن صيامه يعدل صيام عشرة أشهر.
- ٩- أن من قام فيه مع الإمام حتى ينصرف كتب له قيام ليلة.
- ١٠- أن العمرة فيه تعدل حجة.
- ١١- أنه يسكن الاعتكاف فيه، لمواظبة النبي صلى الله عليه وسلم عليه.
- ١٢- يستحب في رمضان استحباباً مؤكداً مدارس القرآن وكثرة تلاوته.
- ١٣- يستحب في رمضان تفطير الصائم ولو على تمر وماء.

- ١- أن الله عز وجل جعل صومه الركن الرابع من أركان الإسلام.
- ٢- أن الله عز وجل أنزل فيه القرآن .
- ٣- أن الله جعل فيه ليلة القدر التي هي خير من ألف شهر.
- ٤- أن الله عز وجل جعل صيامه وقيامه إيماناً واحتساباً سبباً لمغفرة الذنوب.
- ٥- أن الله عز وجل يفتح فيه أبواب الجنان، ويغلق فيه أبواب النيران، ويصعد فيه الشياطين.
- ٦- أن لله في كل ليلة منه عتقاء من النار

## What Is Ramadan?

Praise be to Allaah.. Ramadan is one of the twelve Arabic months. It is a month which is venerated in the Islamic religion, and it is distinguished from the other months by a number of characteristics and virtues, including the following:

- 1 – Allaah has made fasting this month the fourth pillar of Islam.
- 2 – Allaah revealed the Qur’aan in this month.
- 3 – Allaah has made Laylat al-Qadr in this month, which is better than a thousand months.
- 4 – Allaah has made fasting Ramadan and spending its nights in prayer out of faith and in the hope of reward a means of forgiveness of sins.
- 5 – In this month, Allaah opens the gates of Paradise & closes the gates of Hell, and chains up the devils.
- 6 – Every night Allaah has people whom He redeems from the Fire.
- 7 – Fasting Ramadan is a means of expiation for the sins committed since the previous Ramadan, so long as one avoids major sins.
- 8 – Fasting in Ramadan is equivalent to fasting ten months.
- 9 – Whoever prays qiyaam in Ramadan with the imam until he finishes, it will be recorded for him that he spent the whole night in prayer.
- 10 – Umrah in Ramadan is equivalent to Hajj.
- 11 – It is Sunnah to observe i’tikaaf (retreat for the purpose of worship) in Ramadan.
- 12 – It is mustahabb in the sense of being strongly recommended in Ramadan to study the Qur’aan together and to read it a great deal.
- 13 – It is mustahabb in Ramadan to offer iftaar to those who are fasting even if it comes to dates & water.

Dear School Administrator/Attendance Office,

The Islamic Center of San Antonio would like to inform you that the holy month of Ramadan is expected to begin on February 18, 2026. During this month, Muslims are religiously obligated to fast daily from dawn until sunset, refraining from food, drink, and other physical needs.

In light of this observance, the Islamic Center of San Antonio respectfully requests reasonable accommodations for Muslim students during this period. Specifically, we kindly ask that students be excused from physically strenuous activities, including demanding physical education classes, and be permitted to rest or leave school early if they experience fatigue related to fasting.

Additionally, Muslim students may request excused absences for the two major Islamic holidays, Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha, which are anticipated to fall on March 20, 2026, and May 26/27, 2026, respectively.

Students may also request time each Friday to attend the obligatory weekly congregational prayer (Jumu'ah), typically held between 12:30 PM and 2:30 PM. We respectfully ask that students be permitted to leave and return to school during this time.
